HIT, DRAW, TAP (HDT) COMPETITION

- CurlManitoba introduced the Hit, Draw, Tap Competition for our youth curlers age 6-13 last season. Three categories 6-8, 9-11 and 12-13. It was a huge success and will continue this season.
- Anyone is eligible, they do not have to be a club member.
- The contestants play in their club, 3 athletes from each category plus any ties advance to their regional qualifier and then 3 advance to the Provincial Competition.
- The only cost is \$5 for the regionals with the money going to the club.
- All participants gets a small token for competing.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TOURNAMENTS NEW

COACHING

- CurlManitoba offers Coaching Courses throughout the Province.
- Club Coach (old Level 1) is geared towards club coaching in a league or instructional program.
- Competition Coach (old Level 2) is for volunteers who would like to coach at the competitive level. No pre-requisite is required.
- Respect in Sport Certification is required by all coaches in Manitoba and can be found on the Sport Manitoba website as an online course.
- Making Ethical Decisions on line evaluation is a required course through Coaching Canada.



EVENT ASSISTANTS

- Umpiring is a broad term used for certified umpires at our Championships and club volunteers for our regional qualifiers and berth bonspiels.
- Club Volunteers at regional qualifiers and berth bonspiels are Event Assistants and are not expected to resolve any on-ice issues.
 - An individual with a strong foundation of the rules of curling
 - The individual is provided with an on-call umpire number for assistance throughout an event



UMPIRES

Championship Umpires are used only at CurlManitoba Provincial Events. All other events are unofficiated.

Championship Umpires have become certified in officiating. Certification is required at any CurlManitoba event.

CurlManitoba mentors all our umpires at an events.
