Danny joined the Pembina Curling Club in 1972 and joined their board in 1979. He served on various committees at the club in his 12 years on their board, serving as club president during the 1989-90 season.

In 1987-88 he served his first year of a four-year term as the club rep to the then MCA. In the 1991-92 season, he was elected to MCA Elected Council. In the three years on Elected Council he served on the Junior and Mixed Championship Committees.

The majority of his curling volunteer time involved working as a curling official. For over 30 years, he worked a couple provincial championship events per year before retiring in 2012.

He also volunteered as a statistician at a national event in Winnipeg and World Event in Grand Forks.

He served on the Media Committee during the 1991 Safeway World Championships, A committee member and also selection chairman of the Manitoba Curling Hall of Fame.
