

CurlManitoba is pleased to offer member clubs the opportunity to bring two of the top young curlers who are under 30 in the world to visit Manitoba communities to help teach and promote the sport of curling. The goal of the Road Show is to provide clubs with a resource to attract interest to the sport of curling in their community and to have top curlers conduct clinics for curlers and interested participants assisting them in improving their skills.

CurlManitoba will provide a three-part program to your community.

1. "Try it, you'll like it" clinic for local juniors in two sessions (10-13 year olds from 10am – 12pm and 14-17 years old from 1pm-3pm), designed to help encourage interest in the sport
2. An adult awareness clinic in the evening (5pm – 7pm). The adult clinic is designed to help attract new participants into the club and provide current curlers the opportunity to receive a few tips to improve their game. This session may be hosted the evening prior to the junior sessions.

The evening on ice portion may include a meet and greet (following COVID protocols) with the top young curlers allowing participants the chance to get to visit.

CurlManitoba will require selected clubs to provide the facility at no charge, volunteers to assist with facility flow of the participants. To promote the event in the community and surrounding area.

The program is limited to communities for the upcoming season. The selection will be made, but not limited to, the following criteria:

1. CurlManitoba's best use of resources, both time and financial
2. A minimum of 16 participants
3. Your plan for the event

If your club would like to take part in the program please complete the following application form. Note submitting an application does not guarantee you will receive the event. Applications must be received by October 31, 2020. Clubs must submit a \$50.00 booking fee with their application. The fee will be refunded upon completion of the event.
