



MANITOBA WINTER GAMES

FAQ:

Q: What is the Manitoba Winter Games?

A: The Manitoba Winter Games is a multi-sport competition that takes place every 4 years. The 2022 Manitoba Winter Games will be held in Niverville, with the curling event taking place at the Morris Curling Club.

Q: How do I qualify?

A: Eligible teams must sign up for a CurlManitoba Regional Qualifying event in the region they reside/curl out of.

Sport regions are outlined in the CurlManitoba Rule Supplement.

Q: What is the age eligibility?

A: Age eligibility for the Manitoba Winter Games is as follows:

U15 Born January 1, 2007 or later
Maximum 14 years of age on December 31, 2021

Mixed Doubles Born January 1, 2004 or later

Q: Do my teammates have to curl at the same club?

A: If you curl out of a city of Winnipeg club, all team members must be from the same Curling Club. If you curl in a region outside the city of Winnipeg, members of your team can be made up of any curler that resides/competes in that region.

Q: Can I sign up as an individual?

A: No. Athletes must sign up for Regional Qualifiers as a team (4-person or Mixed Doubles). If you are interested in the Manitoba Winter Games but do not have a team to play on, ask your Junior Program Coordinator or email rgordon@curlmanitoba.org

Q: Can I play on a 4-person team and Mixed Doubles?

A: Yes. Athletes can play both 4-person and Mixed doubles disciplines as they are scheduled during different portions of the Manitoba Winter Games (phase 1 and phase 2).
