

The following changes to [public health orders](#) are currently in effect and expire on Jan. 11, 2022. All updated guidelines for sport and the Sport Manitoba facility are available on our website: www.sportmanitoba.ca/covid-19/

Indoor and Outdoor Sport

- Spectator capacity is reduced to 50 per cent.
- While games and practices can continue, no tournaments (bonspiels) will be permitted.

Indoor sport continues to be restricted to:

- persons who produce proof of vaccination,
- persons who produce proof from the Government of Manitoba that there is a medical reason for the person not to receive a vaccine for COVID-19,
- persons under 12 years of age,
- persons who are at least 12 years of age but who have not yet reached 18 years of age and who produce
 - proof that they have received one dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine for COVID-19, or
 - proof of a negative rapid COVID-19 test result within the previous 72 hours that is confirmed by a pharmacist or by staff at a nursing station on a First Nation

The operator of the restaurant must ensure that (a) the number of members of the public dining at the restaurant does not exceed 50% of the usual seating capacity of the premises; and (b) no more than ten persons are seated at a table at the restaurant.

The operator of the licensed premises must ensure that (a) the number of members of the public at the licensed premises does not exceed 50% of the usual capacity of the premises; (b) no more than ten persons are seated at a table at the licensed premises; (c) members of the public are prevented from physically moving tables or seating in the licensed premises; (d) members of the public are required to be seated, unless they are (i) engaged in playing pool, darts, video games or other similar games or sporting activities offered in the licensed premises, (ii) using video lottery terminals in the licensed premises, (iii) travelling to obtain food or beverages in the licensed premises, (iv) travelling to or from washrooms, (v) briefly interacting with staff at the licensed premises, or (vi) entering or leaving the licensed premises; and (e) no dancing takes place in the licensed premises
