

2023/2024 Hosting Application Criteria for CurlManitoba Member Clubs

***Please Note: Clubs must have a membership history with CurlManitoba for a minimum of 5 years*

Provincial Hosting Opportunities:

TELUS Junior Men's & Women's Provincial Championships (Open Championship in 2022)

This event may be hosted in one club with a minimum of Eight (8) sheets (or use an arena for four (4) sheets and the curling club with four (4) sheets or may be hosted jointly with a club/community in close proximity providing each facility has a minimum of Four (4) sheets

A banquet facility to accommodate a minimum of 185 people is required

A minimum of 100 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Scotties Tournament of Hearts presented by Monsanto

Arena capable of handling 3 sheets of ice

A banquet facility to accommodate a minimum of 100 people

A minimum of 90 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Viterra Championship

Arena capable of handling 5 sheets of ice

A banquet facility to accommodate a minimum of 200 people

A minimum of 150 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Strathcona Trust Senior Men's and Senior Women's Provincial Championships (approx 28 Teams combined)

This event may be hosted in one club with a minimum of Eight (8) sheets or may be hosted jointly with a club/community in close proximity providing each facility has a minimum of Four (4) sheets

A facility to accommodate a minimum of 130 people is required for a cocktail reception

A minimum of 65 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Chicken Chef Provincial Mixed,

Curling Club with a minimum of Four (4) Sheets of Ice

A facility to accommodate a minimum of 85 is required for a cocktail reception

A Minimum of 40 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Manitoba's Credit Unions Provincial Masters Provincial Championships: Men's (16 teams) and Women's (Open)

Curling Club with a minimum of Five (5) Sheets of Ice

A facility to accommodate a minimum of 100 people is required for a cocktail reception

A Minimum of 50 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Curling Club Provincial Championships: Men's and Women's (24 teams)

Curling Club with a minimum of Six (6) Sheets of Ice

A facility to accommodate a minimum of 100 people is required for a cocktail reception

A Minimum of 50-60 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

Asham U18 Provincial Championships: Men's, Women's(Open Championship in 2022), Mixed Doubles (Open)

Curling Club with a minimum of Six (6) Sheets of Ice

A Minimum of 80 rooms which can include quality hotel rooms, B&B and houses (close proximity may be considered)

****** A site visit may be required prior to the awarding of Provincial Championships**

*******Clubs wishing to host the following events *MAY BE* required to host another event (CurlManitoba's choice) prior to hosting the event which the club bid on: Canola Junior Men's and Women's Provincial Championships, Viterra Championship, Strathcona Senior Men's Senior Championship, and Scotties Tournament of Hearts Women's Provincial Championship presented by Monsanto.**

Berth Hosting Opportunities

Berth Bonspiel (up to 32 teams)

Any CurlManitoba Member Club that has been affiliated for at least 5 years may apply to host a Berth Bonspiel, but must have a plan in place to complete the bonspiel in the allotted time. Smaller clubs (with 3 sheets or less) **MUST** include the name of a nearby club(s) whose ice will be used if entry numbers require extra ice for any number of draws. A suitable number of quality Hotel Rooms within the host community (close proximity may be considered) is also a requirement.

Bonspiels with a Berth

Clubs can inquire about hosting a Senior Men's or Master Men's Bonspiel with a Berth. The bonspiel will have some requirements in place but the host club is responsible for collecting entries and implementing the bonspiel. There is a \$500 fee to host.

Note: The berth winner must pay a \$225 CurlManitoba fee to participate in the Provincial Championship.

******* Based on the number of entries received (Berth Bonspiels), clubs will be advised if the second club would be required. In smaller bonspiels, every effort will be made to conduct the event in the Host Club.**
