

RULE CHANGES 2022-2023

The on-ice coaching introduced in the 2021-22 season will be in effect for U18 and Junior Provincial Championships.

Senior Men and Master Men Championships

There will be no tie breakers scheduled.

The top team in each pool will advance to the 1 vs 1 game.

The second and third place teams in each pool will play a sudden death cross over playoff game to determine the teams that advance to the 2 vs 2 game. Pool A 2nd vs Pool B 3rd; Pool A 3rd vs Pool B 2nd.

If teams are tied for third place in their pool the tie will be determined first by their head to head game during the round robin and if a tie remains the LSD will be used to determine placement.

Senior Men and Master Men eligibility

All four or five competitors on a team shall not necessarily come from one club, but may be chosen from any club within their Sport Region. All City of Winnipeg member clubs constitute one Sport Region for entry purposes.

Championships Spare Pool

There will NOT be a spare pool available at any Provincial Championships. Fifth players are allowed at all Championships and must be named 7 days prior to the start of the event. If a spare is required during the event the spare must play lead. Any spare must meet all eligibility requirements.

Dress Code

1. All team members (including the coach) attending a Championship banquet/cocktail party are expected to dress in business casual attire or their competitive uniforms. (No blue jeans allowed)

Exception: U18
Curling Club
4 Person Mixed

2. Teams are required to have matching on ice apparel which are to be worn at all times when the team is on the ice including practices, games and all ceremonies.

Exception: U18
4 person Mixed
Curling Club Championship

3. If a team attends in poor fashion the penalty will be loss of last stone in the first game the team has earned the last stone.
4. A CurlManitoba Representative or a CurlManitoba Umpire will enforce the dress code.
5. Team uniforms must display the sponsor crests at all times.

Berth Bonspiels with 2 berths allotted

If a Berth Bonspiel with 2 Berths allotted (Men, Senior and Master) has 8 teams or more, the event will award 2 Berths. If the Berth Bonspiel has 4-7 teams, the event will award 1 berth and the other berth will revert to the Regional Qualifier pool. If the Berth Bonspiel has less than 4 teams the event will be cancelled.
