Rob's involvement in curling dates back to his days as a teacher at St James Collegiate where he was the teacher supervisor of a school league that played out of the Valour Road Curling Club in the early 70's

In 1973, he served as coach of the 1973 Manitoba Junior Champions - Dave Iverson Team from St. James Collegiate.

Rob served as the Deer Lodge Club rep to MCA Council in the 1982-83 season.

Was a member of the Manitoba Curling Foundation from 2003/04 to 2008/09, with the final year serving as its president.

Rob has been involved in the officiating side of curling. He has been a timer at numerous provincial events since the days of the old chess clocks.

He served as Head Umpire at the 1980 Tankard at the Winnipeg Arena, He served on the host committee of the 1996, 2004 and 2017 Senior Men's provincial hosted at Deer Lodge, Served as Chairman of officials for the 2003 World Curling Championships, Team driver for 1998 Winnipeg Brier, Statistician at 2013 Roar of the Rings

At the club level he joined the Deer Lodge Curling club in 1974. Elected to the Board of Directors in 1978 and served 10 years on the board, including a term as president in 1986-87. He was named an HLM at Deer Lodge in 1999.
