Provincial Masters

The event began with 16 teams. From 1982 to 1985 the teams were split into Groups A and B, playing a semi-modified draw with the winners playing a single knockout final. From 1986 to 1990 a semi-modified draw was used. In 1991 the event changed to a round robin format with groups of 8 teams, with the top two teams in each group playing a straight knockout final. In 2007, the playoff format changed to the Page Playoff. In 2023, a change saw the top three teams in each round robin pool qualify for the playoff round. The first place teams advance to the 1 vs 1 game and the 2nd place teams play the third place team in the opposite pool with the winners advancing to the 3 vs 4 game.

Canadian Masters

The first championship was held in 1987 with the 4 western provinces. In 2000, the event changed to a Canadian Open format where provinces choose to send a team or not. In 2016, the format was changed to playing in two groups with the top teams in each group advancing to the Championship round robin followed by a semi final and final. In 2023, 14 teams competed with top 4 in each group advancing to championship round where the top 4 teams advance to playoff with 1-4 and 2-3.

Provincial Final

Since 2007 the Page Playoff has been used to determine the champion. In the 18 years of this playoff system, the winner of the 1 vs 2 game has gone on to win on 8 occasions. On 6 occasions the loser of the 1 vs 2 game, came back to win. The team coming from the 3 vs 4 winner has won four times. Teams skipped by Ron Westcott (2014) and Mark Franklin (2016) (2018), Randy Neufeld in 2023 are the only teams to register unbeaten 9-0 records
