Provincial

From 1925 to 1958 teams played a straight knockout format. This was played in conjunction with the MCA Bonspiel. In some years as few as 14 teams qualified and a maximum of 64 teams qualified. Exceptions to this included 1930 to 1932 where the MCA Bonspiel Grand Aggregate Winner was declared Provincial Champion. In 1949 a round robin format was used with 12 teams. In 1959, a 16 team double knockout draw was introduced. In 1960, the current format of a maximum of 32 teams was started, however if a team qualified twice, the numbers were reduced accordingly. In 1965, minimum 32 teams became the yearly number to compete. There have been various types of draws used to declare the champions over the years. In 1995, the 8 team qualifier was introduced and in 2003 the Final Four or Page Playoff was introduced. In 2021 there was no playdown because of the pandemic. In 2022 only 28 teams competed in a curling club setting due to restrictions. In 2026, a new draw was introduced with 24 teams playing a triple knockout with 6 qualifiers, followed by a Page Playoff.

Canadian Men's

The idea of a national competition began in 1925, with the Manitoba Champion heading east to play a series of exhibition games against eastern teams. In 1927 the first Brier was held with 8 teams competing with only one team representing Western Canada. (Manitoba lost the play in game to Saskatchewan) The teams played 14 ends against each of the other teams with no playoff unless the teams were tied for first place. In 1928, the games were shortened to 12 ends with 10 teams competing. In 1936, PEI and British Columbia were added and in 1951 Newfoundland/Labrador, in 1975 The Territories were added. In 1977, games were shortened to 10 ends. There was no Brier held from 1943-1945. In 1979, the last Brier was held where no playoff games, unless teams were tied. In 1980, the playoff format was changed to the first place team receiving a bye to the final and the second and third place teams playing a semi-final game to see who would advance to the final. In 1995, the Page Playoff format was adopted. In 2018, the event was expanded to 16 teams in two pools of 8 teams. A wildcard entry was added. In 2021, because of the pandemic the championship was expanded to 18 teams in two pools of nine. Two additional wildcard entries were added based on the ranking system, one of the wildcard teams was from Manitoba. In 2022, three additional wildcards were added. Two pools of 9 with top three playing down to four and page playoff final. In 2023, The second- and third-ranked teams in each pool crossover to play in a Page playoff qualifying games, the winners advance to the Page playoff seeding games to play the top-ranked teams in each pool (2nd in B/3rd in A vs. 1st in A & 2nd in A/3rd in B vs. 1st in B). The winners of the Page playoff seeding games advance to the Page 1v2 game and the losers advance to the Page 3v4 game. In 2024, the format changed to the first and second place teams playing crossing over where 1 played 2 and same in the other division with the winners advancing to the 1 vs 1 page playoff and the losers dropping down to play the third place team for the right to advance to the 3 vs 4 page playoff.

World Men's

In 1959, the first world men's championship was held with teams from Canada and Scotland competing. In 1961, the USA joined as did Sweden until finally 10 teams qualified in 1973. The teams played a round robin followed by a straight knockout involving the top four teams with 1 vs 4 and 2 vs 3. There are now 12 teams that compete. In 2005, the Page Playoff format was adopted. The championship was not played in 2020.

Provincial Final

Since 2003 the Page Playoff has been used to determine the champion. In the 22 years of this playoff system, the winner of the 1 vs 2 game has gone on to win on 13 occasions. On 6 occasions the loser of the 1 vs 2 game has come back to win (2004 Scales, 2008 Burtnyk, 2010 and 2013 Stoughton, 2017, 2022 McEwen, Jacobs 2024). Three times the 3 vs 4 winner claimed the championship. 2012 Fowler, 2023 Dunstone 2025 Carruthers.
